Please join us at the Utica Curling Club for our famous Mens International Invitational, the Mitchell Bonspiel. Alexander Mitchell, patron of the Grand National, placed the medal in competition in

February of 1885. This year will mark the 102nd anniversary of the event in Utica.

The Mitchell will be played at our facility featuring 6 sheets of ice, a large bar, dining room and lots of parking. The bonspiel has 6 events with 4-game guarantee "knock-out". Sign-up is limited to 36 teams. We will reserve a spot in the bonspiel for last year's participants until November 30, 2012. After that new entries are accepted in the order received. Last year the bonspiel was filled in early December, so get your entry in ASAP. Your check is not cashed until you are accepted into the Bonspiel, and informed of your acceptance.

The entry fee is again \$360.00 U.S. funds – we are providing the same dinner! Meal ticket books are \$90.00 for the fifth man; guests or spouses \$80. No post-dated checks accepted.

Alexander Mitchell, a Scott from Aberdeenshire, moved to Milwaukee in 1839 as the representative of a Scottish insurance company. He became a leading banker, industrialist and then President of the Chicago, Milwaukee & St. Paul Railway. In December 1884, he donated the Mitchell Gold Medal for annual competition to be "played in the Eastern and Western sections alternately with the Gordon Champion Rink Medal". Mr. Mitchell died of pneumonia in the spring of 1887. The last Western Competition was held February 1898 in St. Paul. After that the Mitchell was held only in the East. In 1916 the Utica Curling Club was made the permanent host of the Bonspiel.
