Message to Members

I hope everyone enjoyed the summer. The board has been busy addressing the issues raised at the annual meeting as well as our regular activities such as developing the budget and schedule of events for the upcoming season.

You may have noticed in the dues statement you received there is a new membership class for juniors. This Junior Plus category allows more competitive juniors additional opportunities for higher levels of play through limited participation in adult events. The new membership class was adopted at the special membership meeting held at the club on June 21. A few other minor changes to the by-laws were also adopted at that meeting. Now, notification of certain events can be provided electronically to those members who choose that method. Conventional USPS delivery will be maintained for those who choose.

Two events were held at the club over the summer. First was a show by the Antique Bottle Club in May, followed by a garage sale put on by Teens For Christ in June. During the latter event, it was noticed that a leak had developed in the ceiling causing some minor flooding in the dining area. Dave Russell is supervising the roof repair along with several other, more minor, upgrades. Thanks Dave.

At the board's request, Roger Rowlett performed a more detailed analysis of our electricity usage considering "degree-days" over the past couple of years. It appears that we saved about 18% with the new ceiling, giving a payback on our investment of about 3 years. Thanks Roger.

MORE HISTORY! WHAT WAS ...?

The Red and Blue Bonspiel

Although records are sketchy, it appears that Utica held a Club Bonspiel called the Red-Blue Match on New Year's Day to mark the opening of the season. It appears this tradition ran from the early 1890's through the 1940's, and it pitted teams of club members selected by the Club President (Reds) and Vice-President (Blues) in a one-day event followed by a banquet.

Utica Daily Press – January 1, 1937

"Utica Curling Club opens its 1937 season officially at 10:00 am today on its rinks, 1413 (sic) Francis Street. For over 50 years the club has celebrated the opening of its season each year with the annual frays between the rinks of the president and vice president on New Year's Day, and this custom is being followed this year.

In these matches all of the members of the club are divided into rinks representing the two officers. The rinks are then matched against each other and the side totaling the most number of stones is declared the winner. In addition to the games the club will have open house all day and all members, past and present, will join in the festivities."
